# **Digital Presentation Structure & Content Guidelines**

All digital submissions should **follow this structure** for content clarity and fair assessment, regardless of format:

#### 1. Title

- Clear, creative, and directly related to the proposed solution
- Maximum 15 words

#### 2. Problem Statement

- Define the waste management challenge being addressed
- Contextualize it within the Indian setting
- Explain relevance, urgency, and gaps
- Include visuals where relevant (map, image, graph)



#### 3. Proposed Solution

- Describe your innovative approach (behavioural, systemic, or policy-based)
- Highlight feasibility, sustainability, and potential for scale

## 4. Stakeholder Analysis

- Identify actors involved (e.g., government, community, youth, NGOs, private sector)
- Explain roles and interdependencies
- Use a stakeholder map or matrix, if possible

# 5. Potential Impact

- Describe short-term and long-term impacts
- Quantify wherever possible
- May align with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

### 6. Visuals & Infographics

- Use charts, flow diagrams, timelines, and images to support understanding
- Ensure clarity, simplicity, and visual balance
- Avoid clutter or excessive text

#### 7. Author/Team Information

- Full name(s), category (Junior/Senior), institution name, and contact email
- Mention if mentored or developed through any program/club
- Optionally include a photo or team logo (small, bottom corner)
