ONLINE PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Submitted entries will undergo a rigorous screening process by a committee consisting of senior academicians and industry practitioners. The shortlisted entries after the screening will be invited to present their ideas in an online presentation round, scheduled for October 2025. Top 10 entries (5 Junior + 5 Senior or flexible based on merit) will be selected from this round to advance to the Final Digital Presentation & Live Jury Session during the conference in January 2026.

Tentative Schedule:

- Presentation Window: 1–15 October 2025
- Session Duration: 10–15 minutes (including 3–5 mins Q&A)
- Mode: Online (Zoom/Google Meet link will be shared)

Presentation Format:

Prepare a concise presentation covering your content. You may use digital formats:

- 1. Title Slide
 - o Team name, project title, category (Junior/Senior), institution
- 2. Problem Statement
 - Clear articulation of the problem and its relevance
- 3. Proposed Strategic Solution
 - Focused on policy, systemic, or stakeholder-led solutions (not just technical models)
- 4. Stakeholder Engagement
 - o Who are the stakeholders, and how will they be involved?
- 5. Potential Impact
 - Describe expected outcomes and long-term benefits
- 6. Implementation Pathway
 - o Practical roadmap or approach to realizing the idea
- 7. Team Structure
 - o Roles and contributions of each member (and mentor, if any)
- 8. Optional: Expression of Interest in Mentorship Support and International Youth Cohort



Evaluation Criteria:

- Clarity & Relevance of Problem (10%)
- Originality & Strategic Value of Solution (25%)
- Feasibility & Vision (25%)
- Alignment with Circular Economy/Low-Carbon Goals (15%)
- Stakeholder Mapping & Inclusiveness (15%)
- Presentation Skills (10%)
